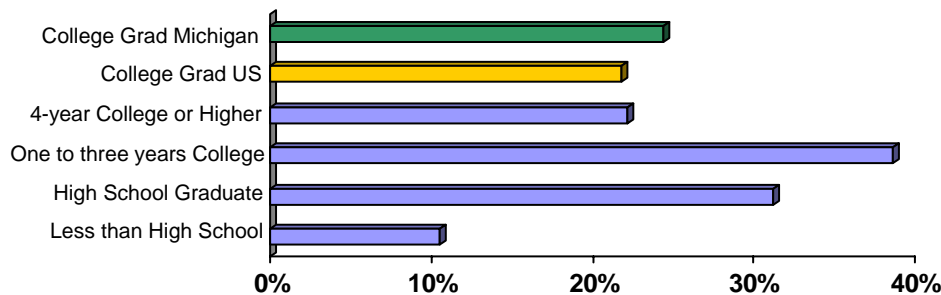

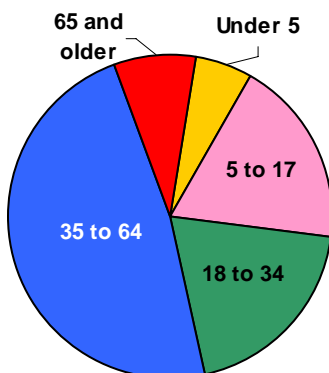
Private Schools

Educational Attainment of People Over 25 Years of Age



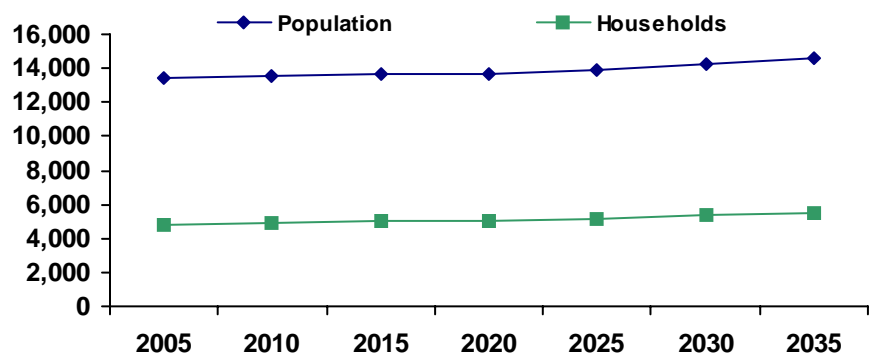
Colleges and Universities

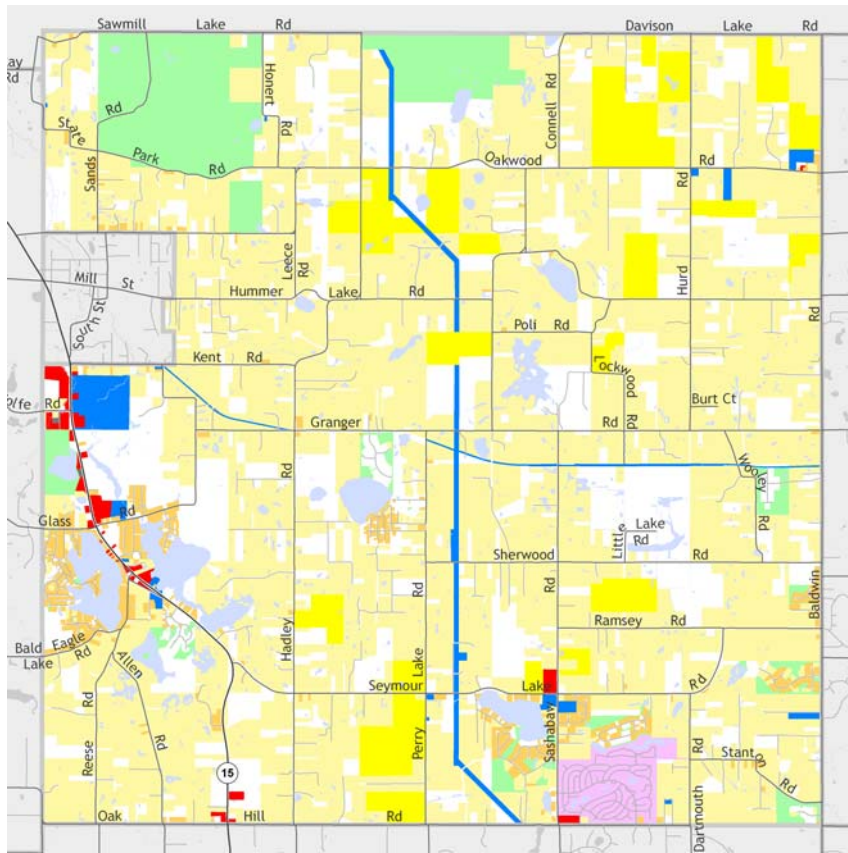
Population and Household Growth



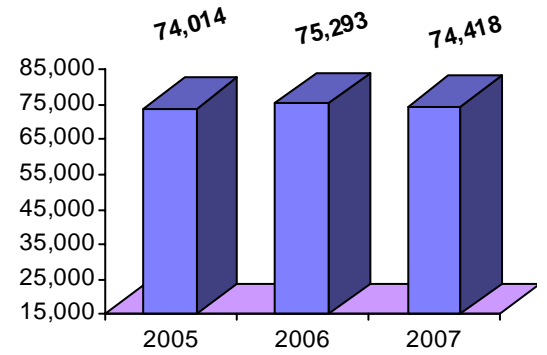
