**Comments:**

The MDOT representative raised concerns about how the Oakland County program would interact with the State program:

- Would we be giving CSS recommendations that would affect state roads and may conflict with their program giving citizens unrealistic expectations.
- Some state roads crossing through many CVTs with differing characters, how would the County program deal with this – would a theme be developed for the roadway, or would there be noticeable changes in character along the roadway.

How will the program deal with zoning and parking requirements impact on CSS?

How will we deal with roadways along county boundaries like Dequindre?

How will Web access be used to review CSS and other types of development proposals?

What are the next steps?

Greenbook – needs to be factored into the project and the full range of design options considered as the Green Book allows.
