That's why I encourage Oakland County homeowners to empower themselves by signing up for the Property Records Notification (PRN) tool on our website. We suggest using your property's property identification number (PIN). This is just one of the services we provide to help make life a little more secure for Oakland County families. 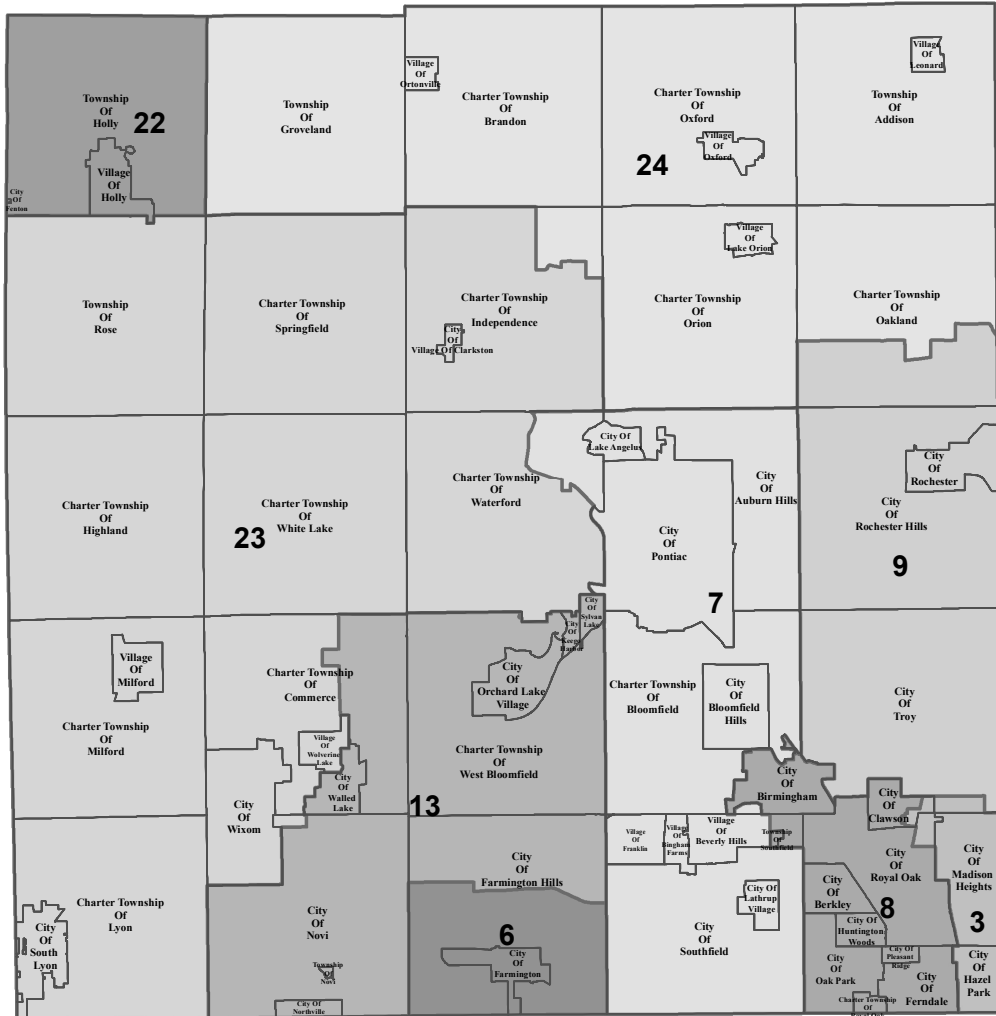

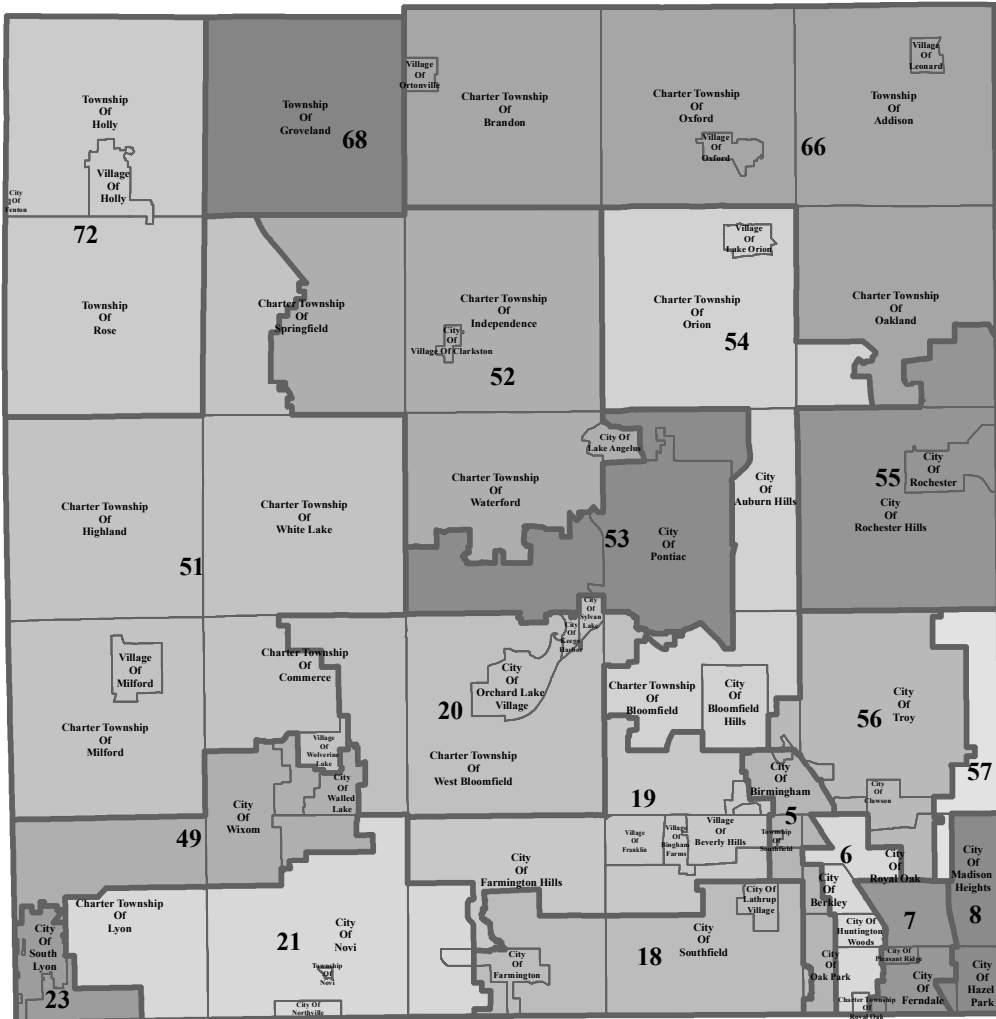

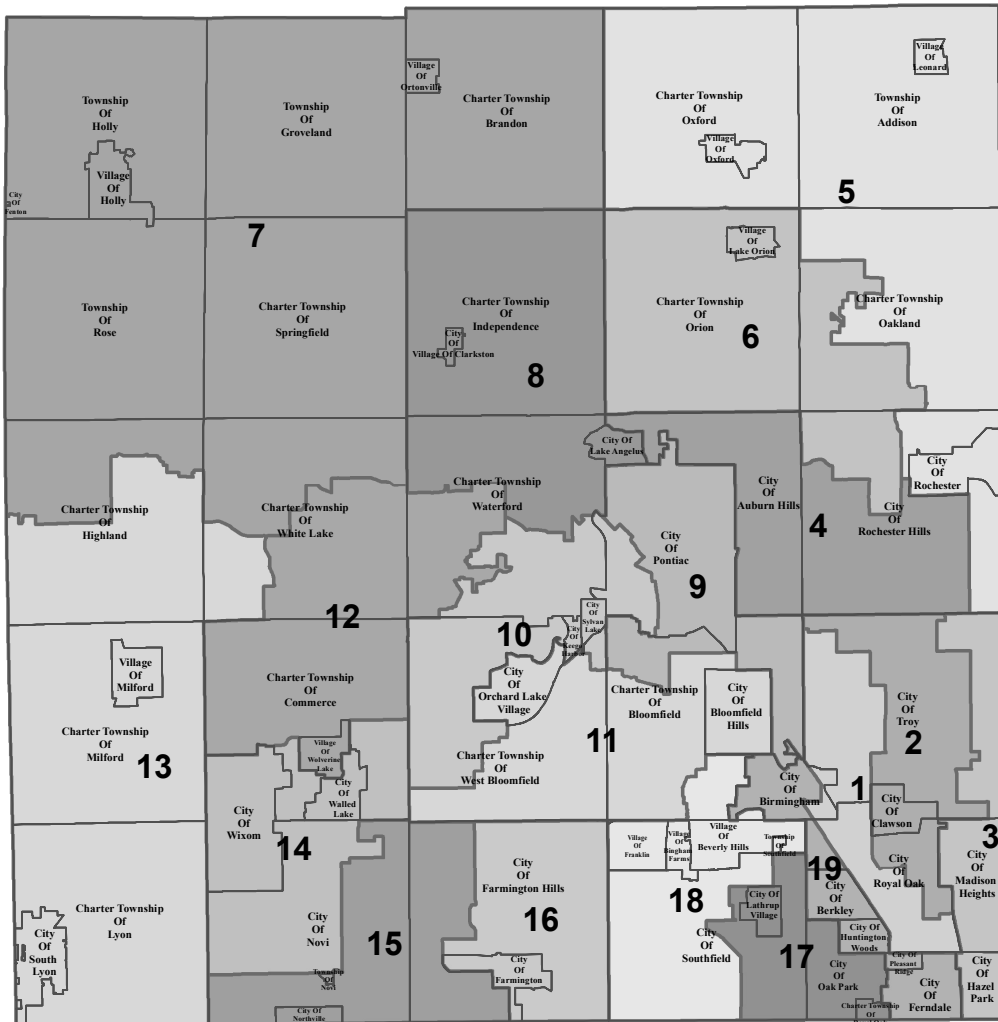

OAKLAND COUNTY GOVERNMENT

In August of 1974, Oakland County citizens voted to create the first optional unified form of county government in the history of Michigan. Less than 60 such governments exist across the nation.

The government is headed by an elected County Executive with responsibilities similar to those of a governor or the mayor of a large city. The County Executive administers the government on a day-to-day basis, proposes new programs, and revamps existing programs. The County Executive represents the interests of more than 1.2 million residents.

Under this structure the Board of Commissioners performs a role similar to a state legislature or city council. It acts on proposals submitted by the County Executive and makes proposals of its own. It possesses the legislative and administrative powers granted by State Law. The County Executive may veto acts of the Board and the vetoes can be overridden by a two-thirds vote of the Board.

The executive form of government did not change the third branch of government, the judiciary. Similarly, the five other offices headed by officials elected countywide remain unchanged. These are the Prosecutor, the Sheriff, the Clerk/Register of Deeds, the Treasurer, and the Water Resources Commissioner.

OAKLAND COMMUNITY HEALTH NETWORK

Oakland Community Health Network's (OCHN) mission is to inspire hope, empower people, and strengthen communities. It achieves these important objectives by identifying, influencing, and delivering comprehensive, public mental health services to Oakland County citizens.

OCHN provides services to more than 27,000 Oakland County residents who have an intellectual/developmental disability, mental health challenge, substance use disorder, as well as children with serious emotional disturbances and their families. Most of these individuals receive Medicaid, Healthy Michigan, or MiChild services.

A full array of mental health and community-based services are offered through OCHN's contracted, service provider network, including evaluation and screening; hospital and residential treatment; respite care; clubhouse and day programs, supported employment; multilingual programs, correction services, and dual diagnosis for individuals with both a mental health and substance use disorder.

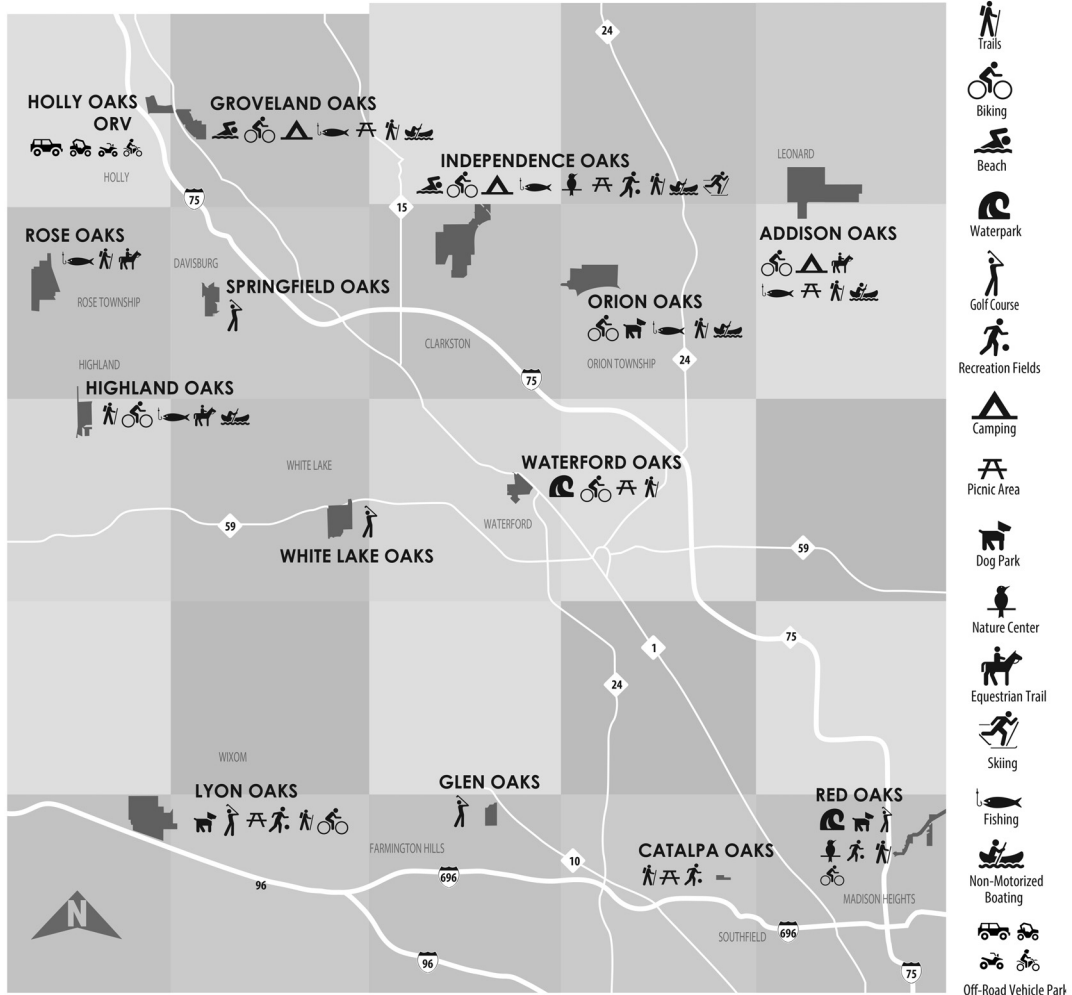
OCHN's service provider network is comprised of highly well-respected community organizations. This includes: Common Ground, Community Housing Network, Community Living Services, CNS Healthcare, Easterseals MORC, Oakland Family Services, and Training and Treatment Innovations, Inc. A complete list of substance use prevention/treatment and autism service providers is available on OCHN's website at www.oaklandchn.org. While each service provider specializes in a specific treatment area, they all work together to achieve the common goal of reaching out and getting appropriate help to people in need in order to improve their quality of life and strengthen Oakland County's community as a whole.

OCHN manages a \$300 million dollar budget and funding for more than 300 services sites. More than 90% of OCHN funding for mental health services is provided by two sources: Medicaid capitation payments and the State General Fund. An additional four percent of its funding is provided by Oakland County. Ninety-five percent of OCHN's funding is designated for contracted supports and services for Oakland County residents, with approximately 4% used for administrative expenses.

OCHN is also fully certified by the State of Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) as required by the state Mental Health Code.

DISCOVER YOUR NEXT ADVENTURE AT OAKLAND COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION

Oakland County Parks and Recreation (OCPR) is dedicated to creating and operating accessible, welcoming and sustainable parks and public spaces; providing recreational and educational programs and opportunities; preserving open space; stewarding the environment; helping all people be healthier; and building resilient, connected communities in Oakland County.

Throughout its history, which dates to when the parks system was first established in 1966, OCPR has played an important role in the lives of Oakland County residents. Many have cherished memories of taking family camping trips, walking the trails, attending nature programming, enjoying golf outings or spending hot summer days at the waterpark.

The parks system started with 200 acres. Today, it boasts nearly 80 miles of trails across 14 parks and hosts more than two million visitors each year. OCPR provides a huge variety of recreation, leisure and learning opportunities at two nature centers, four dog parks, five golf courses, a waterpark, a wave pool, an ORV park and the Oakland County Farmers Market, which offers fresh produce and products from local farmers and artisans year-round.

Oakland County residents have consistently supported the maintenance and growth of the parks system by approving every millage vote since 1966. In November 2020, voters approved an increase from .2310 to .35 mills until 2029. This millage increase is being invested in maintenance and improvement projects throughout the parks system and to provide free annual vehicle permits to eligible Oakland County residents, including seniors (62 and older), active military, veterans and residents with permanent disabilities.

OCPR is constantly evolving. Over the past year, significant developments have included:

- Adopting the 2023-2027 Recreation Master Plan that includes new vision, mission and core values for the organization
- Securing \$15 million in federal funding for park improvements and new partnerships with local communities that will expand the park system and build stronger connections to urban population centers in the county
- Securing \$2.26 million in Community Project Funding from Congress to support renovations and improvements to the Farmers Market
- Collaborating with local municipalities to fund park and trail improvement projects through the Community Grant Program
- Collaborating with local municipalities to fund high priority invasive species projects through the Invasive Species Community Projects initiative
- Restoring many pre-pandemic programs and services

Addison Oaks County Park and Campground – 1480 W. Romeo Rd. in Leonard
(248) 693-2432

This 1,140-acre natural oasis offers camping, boating, picnicking, fishing and more. It features a 24-hole disc golf course and an extensive trail system. There are more than 20 miles of trails for hiking, mountain or fat tire biking, cross-country skiing and equestrian use. The campground offers individual and group sites, rental cabins and yurts, and campground recreation activities. The historic, Tudor-style **Buhl Estate**, located in the park, is perfect for weddings, banquets, reunions, receptions and more.

Catalpa Oaks County Park – 27705 Greenfield Rd. in Southfield (248) 464-8953

This park offers nearly 25 acres of open space with four soccer fields and a universally accessible playscape and swings for all abilities. It also has a modern restroom facility, picnic pavilion and an aggregate pathway around the perimeter of the park. It is also home to the Annual Great Marshmallow Drop, a spring event drawing 5,000 visitors who watch 15,000 marshmallows drop from a helicopter.

Glen Oaks Golf Course – 30500 13 Mile Rd. in Farmington Hills (248) 851-8356

This picturesque, 18-hole, par 70 course includes a 1920s English-style stone clubhouse with a grill room, banquet facilities and an outdoor patio. The clubhouse also offers a pro shop with a club room. A formal garden on the grounds is ideal for outdoor weddings and other special occasions

Groveland Oaks County Park and Campground – 14555 Dixie Highway in Holly (248) 634-9811

This 360-acre park and campground on Stewart Lake features a sandy beach with swimming, fishing, boating and pedal boating. It also has three large children's playscapes, a skateboard park, court games, a GaGa ball pit, 18-hole mini golf course, skate park and paved trail. Pedal boats, kayaks and bikes are available to rent. Campers have a choice of modern individual or group campsites, rental cabins and yurts.

Highland Oaks County Park – 6555 Milford Rd. in Highland (248) 858-0916

Located within the headwaters of the Shiawassee River, this 302-acre park preserves sensitive habitat while providing excellent recreational experiences in a beautiful natural setting among rolling hills, wetlands and pastures. It has 2.5 miles of multi-purpose trails that provide an opportunity for hiking, mountain or fat tire biking, geocaching, cross-country and equestrian activities. Fishing is also permitted on the accessible floating dock.

Holly Oaks ORV Park – 14551 Shields Rd. in Holly (248) 653-0710

This 235-acre park, consisting of former active sand and gravel mines, is located off I-75 at the Grange Hall Rd. exit and Dixie Highway, across from Groveland Oaks County Park and Campground. It features extreme terrain that ranges from mud flats to 40' vertical cliffs and is open to all types of ORVs, including full-size vehicles, side-by-sides, ATVs and motorcycles. There is a daily entry fee, and an ORV license and trail permit is required. This park is a joint state-county project operated by OCPR in partnership with the Michigan Department of Natural Resources (MDNR).

Independence Oaks County Park – 9501 Sashabaw Rd. in Clarkston (248) 625-0877

This 1,286-acre park – the largest in the Oakland County Parks system – features year-round recreation with more than 12 miles of trails for hiking, biking, in-line skating and cross-country skiing. The 68-acre Crooked Lake provides fishing and boating fun and swimming is available at Hidden Beach. Visitors can also enjoy an archery range, picnic areas, rental shelters, court games and playground equipment. The **Wint Nature Center** offers interpretive exhibits and year-round nature education programs and activities. Its Great Room is an ideal location for children's birthday parties and other special events. The nature center is also home to the Rubach Sensory Garden, a water garden and the Cohn Outdoor Amphitheater. **Camp Wilderness** offers camping experiences to youth groups and features platform tents, shelter, a fire circle, a modern bathhouse and access to park amenities.

Independence Oaks-North – 10089 Sashabaw Rd. in Clarkston (248) 625-0877

This park features a 312-foot boardwalk connecting to a 180-foot-long fishing dock. It is a destination for fishing, hiking, birdwatching and non-motorized boating. Anglers can launch canoes, kayaks or other non-motorized boats. Upper Bushman Lake is catch-and-release only as designated by the Michigan Department of Natural Resources (MDNR).

Lyon Oaks County Park and Golf Course – 52221 Pontiac Trl. in Wixom (248) 437-1488

This park preserves 800 acres of environmentally-sensitive wetlands within its 1,041 acres. It features an Arthur Hills-designed 18-hole golf course with a driving range and elegant banquet facilities. The day-use area has a picnic shelter and playground, volleyball, horseshoe pits, soccer fields and – unique to Lyon Oaks – a cricket pitch. There are six miles of trails for biking, on-leash dog walking and cross-country skiing. Dogs can play off-leash at the popular 13-acre, fenced **Lyon Oaks Dog Park**.

Orion Oaks County Park – 1200 Joslyn Rd. in Orion (248) 625-0877

More than 916 acres of environmentally-sensitive green space is preserved within this park, which offers boating and fishing on the 90-acre Lake Sixteen, as well as 10 miles of trails for hiking, biking and cross-country skiing. An accessible fishing dock and 120-foot boardwalk links two trail systems. The 24-acre **Orion Oaks Dog Park** (enter from Joslyn Rd. between Scripps Rd. and Clarkston Rd.) features picnic areas, trails, small-dog and large-dog areas and a dogs-only swimming area.

Red Oaks County Park – Multiple addresses in Madison Heights (248) 585-0100

This 163-acre park is, which sits atop the enclosed George W. Kuhn Drain, is a unique example of repurposing urban land for recreational use. It features a dog park, golf course, nature center, waterpark and youth soccer complex. The **Red Oaks Dog Park** (31353 Dequindre Rd.) offers more than five acres with three fenced enclosures, a small-dog area and a picnic shelter. At the **Red Oaks Golf Course** (29600 John R. Rd), golfers can enjoy a 9-hole, Jerry Matthews-designed course that also offers FootGolf. The **Red Oaks Waterpark** (1455 E. 13 Mile Rd.) offers fun for all ages with a wave pool, giant triple waterslide, a river ride and a new splashpad with 52 interactive water features, including a water play climber with slides and dumping bucket. The **Red Oaks Nature Center** (30300 Hales St.) features interpretive nature and live animal exhibits, interactive displays, a sensory trail and a storybook trail. It also provides opportunities for field trips, birthday parties, scouting programs and more. The **Red Oaks Youth Soccer Complex** (29601 John R. Rd.) features soccer fields, a concession building with restrooms, a meeting space and a playground.

Rose Oaks County Park – 10501 Buckhorn Lake Rd. in Holly (248) 858-0916

Approximately 640 undeveloped acres are preserved in this park, which features frontage on several glacial lakes, open meadows, wooded uplands and 200 acres of wetlands. Visitors can enjoy accessible boardwalks and floating docks, fishing and non-motorized or electric-motor boats (carry-in only), and explore five miles of natural trails for hiking, biking and equestrian use.

Springfield Oaks County Park and Golf Course – 12451 Andersonville Rd. in Davisburg (248) 599-2708

This 332-acre park includes an 18-hole golf course that is conveniently located just north of Clarkston but has an “up north” feel. A multi-purpose activity center hosts banquets, receptions and 4-H events. The park is also home to the historic **Ellis Barn**, which is a popular site for charming, rustic weddings. Springfield Oaks is also home to the annual **Oakland County Fair**, which draws over 100,000 visitors to the 10-day event.

Waterford Oaks County Park – Multiple addresses in Waterford (248) 858-0916

This 199-acre park is home to the Parks Commission and OCPA administrative offices (2800 Watkins Lake Rd.). It features the world-class **Waterford Oaks Bicycle Motorcross (BMX) Track**, the universally accessible Paradise Peninsula Playscape, a wave pool and platform tennis courts. It also has more than three miles of hiking trails, sand volleyball courts, a winter family sledding hills and outdoor fitness equipment. The Lookout Lodge, Activity Center and picnic shelters are available for rent. The **Waterford Oaks Wave Pool** includes bubbler fountains, a children’s water playground with 30 interactive activities, picnic areas with grills and a bathhouse with showers. Waterford Oaks is also home to the **Oakland County Farmers Market** (2350 Pontiac Lake Rd.), which provides fresh produce and products from local farmers and artisans year-round.

White Lake Oaks Golf Course – 991 Williams Lake Rd. in White Lake (248) 698-2700

This scenic, 18-hole, par 70 course includes 194 acres that feature woodlands and wetlands. It also has a clubhouse with a pro shop, club room and garden patio.

SERVICE CENTER COMPLEX

The Oakland County Service Center Complex has been developed over the past century and functions as the hub of county government. The majority of the county's departments and institutions are presently located on a 443 acre site in the City of Pontiac and Waterford Township. The County developed the Complex by systematically constructing facilities as needed and as funding permitted. It is laid out in a spacious, arboretum-style setting designed to be functional, efficient and aesthetically pleasing. The Service Center was designed with a "community" concept grouping similar or related functions together. It has a Central Heating Plant with high-pressure steam boilers that provide all heating, cooling, and hot water to 14 campus buildings, including the Courthouse and Law Enforcement Complex. It is also serviced by full fiber optic connectivity and a county-owned and operated private telephone business exchange to facilitate state-of-the-art communications between all government units and the public.

The Circuit, Family and Probate Courts, as well as the offices of the Clerk/Register of Deeds, Treasurer, Prosecutor, Law Library and Board of Commissioners reside in the 420,000 square foot Courthouse. Other major facilities located on campus are the Executive Office Building, Animal Shelter, Medical Examiner's Office, North Oakland Health Center, Farmer's Market, Water Resources Commissioner's Office, Sheriff's Headquarters, and Law Enforcement Complex. One of the largest operations on the Service Center is Children's Village. Children's Village is a centrally located campus providing medical, educational, treatment and food services to youth that fall under the authority of Oakland County Family Court or with the State of Michigan Department of Health and Human Services. Children's Village is situated on 50 acres in Waterford Township.

Including the Service Center, the County operates 47 facilities with 1.9 million square feet of space & 600 acres of grounds, to support nearly a hundred departments, divisions, and units. This includes several satellite offices: the Oakland County International Airport (Waterford); South Oakland Health Center (Southfield); South Oakland Office Building (Troy); and the four 52nd District Courts (Rochester Hills, Independence Twp., Novi, and Troy). Parks & Recreation, the Sheriff's Office, and the Water Resources Commissioner also have numerous satellite facilities.

In addition, the Oakland County Sheriff's Office Headquarters and Correctional Facilities are both located on the Service Center Complex. The Correctional Facilities, on average, house over 1,500 inmates in custody every day. The Sheriff's Office has Patrol Services; Traffic and Alcohol Enforcement Unit; Motorcycle Unit; K-9 Unit; Aviation Unit; Marine Unit; Emergency Operations Center; Court Security Services; DNA Lab; Forensic Science Lab; Fire Investigations; Narcotics Enforcement; Computer Crimes; Parks Unit; Fugitive Apprehension Team; Warrants; Friend of the Court Enforcement; Special Investigations Unit; Auto Theft Unit; Training Unit; and the Results Program which offers drug and alcohol testing. The Sheriff's Office participates in regional task forces and also has numerous community service programs available.

The Oakland County Service Center is a model complex and is the core of county government. Oakland's officials are proud of the complex and its related facilities. County citizens and visitors from other counties, states and nations have found, and will continue to find, themselves most welcome.

OAKLAND COUNTY ROADS

Almost half of all highways, roads, and streets in Oakland County are part of the county system, which is under the jurisdiction of the Road Commission for Oakland County.

Totaling more than 2,700 miles, RCOC's road system includes all public roads in townships, except state highways, and through-streets in most cities and villages. It is the largest county system in Michigan, second in size only to the state highway system. Subdivision streets alone (all in townships) make up more than 1,300 miles.

About two-thirds of the system is paved. More than half is within the county's urban area, where some roads are four, five, six and seven lanes wide to handle heavy traffic. A single intersection, in Southfield, is the meeting place for 100,000 vehicles daily. More than 1,200 signals and 150,000 signs are in use on the county road system.

The Road Commission has no authority to levy a countywide tax, nor does anyone levy a tax countywide for roads. The basic source of Road Commission revenue is state-collected vehicle fuel taxes, which motorists pay at the pump, and vehicle registration fees paid to the Secretary of State. The state-collected taxes are the only source of substantial funding for county road maintenance and snow and ice control.

Federal, county, municipal, township and property-owner contributions are also received, but generally only for specific road projects. Such projects include adding lanes, intersection improvements, paving gravel roads, adding new gravel, resurfacing paved roads, adding passing lanes and other safety improvement projects.

In 1992, RCOC embarked on a program called FAST-TRAC, an Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) effort. The Road Commission has installed "smart" traffic signals operated by computers and video vehicle detection at more than 700 intersections across the county. This is the second largest adaptive traffic control system in the United States and the largest video imaging system for traffic management in the world. The Road Commission was the first local unit of government to initiate a program of this scope and magnitude.

For paving and resurfacing of subdivision streets, property owners can petition RCOC to create a special assessment district through a process prescribed by state law. The process begins by contacting the Road Commission, then petitioning and participating in public hearings.

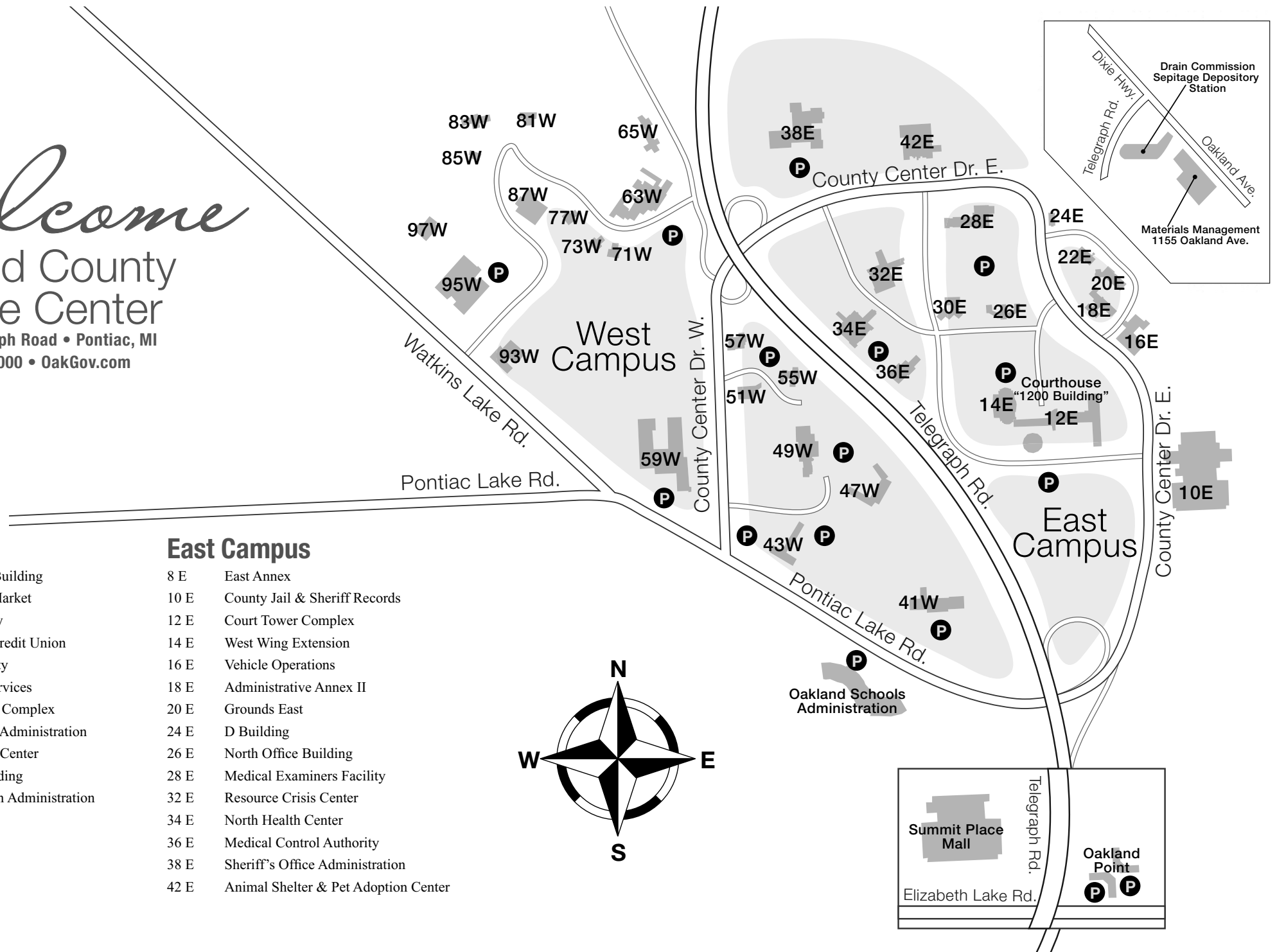
Members of the three-person Board of County Road Commissioners are appointed for staggered six-year terms by the elected Oakland County Board of Commissioners, which also sets their salaries. State-collected vehicle fuel and registration tax revenues fund salaries. The Board of Road Commissioners is separate from county general government – establishing policies as authorized by state statutes for management of the countywide road system, administering its own budget and hiring its own full-time managing director and staff.

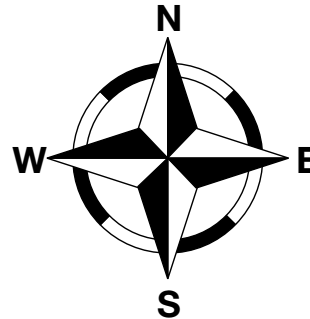
