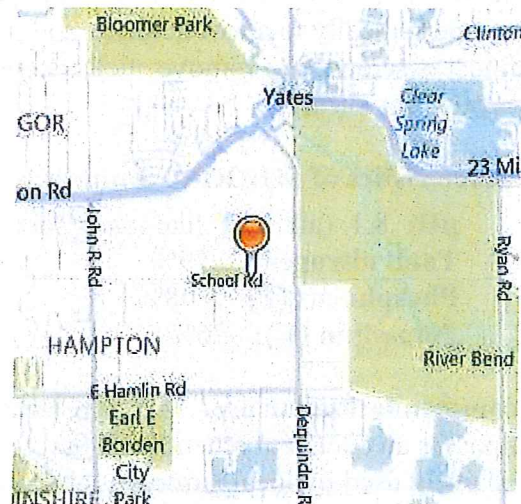

Compost is a natural organic soil amendment and fertilizer, providing many benefits to plants (mix 50/50 with native soils - do not use as potting soil). Compost is known as “gardener’s gold” because it improves soil structure, retains water, encourages root growth, aerates soil, releases nutrients slowly, supports beneficial soil organisms and suppresses some soil-borne diseases.
