OAKLAND COUNTY MS4 Oakland County Parks and Recreation Commission (OCPRC) Municipal Facility Inventory and Assessment MARCH 2023

I. <u>POLICY:</u>

This policy is to establish procedures for inventorying and assessing OCPRC-owned or operated facilities and stormwater structural controls with a discharge of stormwater to surface waters of the state.

II. BACKGROUND:

The EGLE NPDES Phase II Stormwater Discharge Permit requires a procedure for identifying applicant-owned or operated facilities and stormwater structural controls with a discharge of stormwater to surface waters of the state. The inventory shall include the location of each facility and an estimate of the number of structural stormwater controls. This procedure also includes a process for updating and revising this inventory, a process for assessing each facility for the potential to discharge pollutants to surface waters of the state, and a prioritization of each facility based on the potential to discharge pollutants to surface waters of the state.

III. MUNICIPAL INVENTORY AND ASSESSMENT:

Outlined in the table below is a list of OCPRC facilities with a discharge of stormwater to surface waters of the state. The estimated number of stormwater structural controls is identified for each site, along with the priority level of potential discharge of pollutants to waters of the state.

**For facilities that have a high potential to discharge pollutants to surface waters of the state, a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP), Pollution Incident Prevention Plan (PIPP) for salt and chemical storage, and/or a Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasure (SPCC) plan has been developed or are in the process of being developed. These documents are available from OCPRC upon request.

***For facilities that have a medium or low potential for the discharge of pollutants to surface waters of the state, each facility was evaluated for the presence of the following factors (63):

- 0. Absence of any factors
- 1. Presence of urban pollutants stored at the site (i.e. sediment, nutrients, metals, hydrocarbons, pesticides, fertilizers, herbicides, chlorides, trash, bacteria, or other site-specific pollutants
- 2. Identification of improperly stored materials
- 3. Potential for polluting activities to be conducted outside (i.e. vehicle washing)
- 4. Proximity to waterbodies
- 5. Poor housekeeping practices
- 6. Discharge of pollutants of concern to impaired waters

****The majority of OCPRC Facilities participate, or are pursuing participation in, the Michigan Turfgrass Environmental Stewardship Program (MTESP), a voluntary environmental compliance program supported through Michigan State University (MSU) and the Michigan Turf grass Foundation (MTF). For sites not currently certified, MTESP Action Items are available upon request. MTESP Enrollment and Certification Status by Park Facility is summarized in the OCPR Facilities Listing and Stormwater BMP Table (attached).

This inventory will be updated every five (5) years (upon reapplication for stormwater permit coverage) to reassess facilities and structural stormwater controls that have been added, removed, or are no longer owner or operated by OCPRC. Priority level assessments will be revised within 30 days prior to discharging stormwater at a new facility, or when the storage of materials, equipment, or vehicles changes at a facility.

Best Management Practices (BMPs) were identified for each facility with low or medium potential to discharge pollutants to surface waters of the state. For all low facilities where no assessment factors are present, catch basin cleaning and street sweeping will be performed as indicated in the applicable procedures for these activities. For all medium facilities, the appropriate BMPs were considered based on the assessment factor present to prevent or minimize the potential for pollutants from entering surface waters of the state.

Federal Law requires that a facility with a fuel and oil capacity of 1320 gallons stored above ground contained in 55 gallon containers or larger or underground capacity of more than 42,000 gallons develop and have on-site for review a Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasure (SPCC) Plan. The State of Michigan requires a Pollution Incident Prevention Plan (PIPP) when a facility stores polluting materials such as solvents, coolants, and acids in containers of 10 gallons or 100 pounds or more or any defined polluting material(R 324.2009) in any discrete use indoors in quantities over 2200 pounds or outdoors over 440 pounds.
