Head outdoors for fresh air and frosty fun throughout the winter season thanks to activities like cross-country skiing, fat tire biking, snowshoeing, sledding and hiking. There's plenty to see and do snow or no.

A <u>daily pass</u> or <u>Annual Vehicle Permit</u> is required for the following locations: <u>Addison Oaks</u>, <u>Highland Oaks</u>, <u>Independence Oaks</u>, <u>Lyon Oaks</u>, <u>Orion Oaks</u>, <u>Red Oaks</u> (dog park only) and Rose Oaks.

Please purchase permits prior to arrival as permits are not always available at the park during winter months. Parks are generally open from 30 minutes before sunrise to 30 minutes after sundown or as posted at the park. Please call ahead for park hours if you have specific questions.
