YOUTH GROUP CAMPGROUND RULES

- Area must be reserved in advance. No refunds for cancellations due to inclement weather.
- There is a ratio of one adult to five children. The buddy system must be enforced with groups of children.
- Users of the facility must obey all park rules.
- Ground fires are permitted in designated fire circles only. Bundles of wood are available for purchase: \$7/bundle or \$25/4 bundles. No firewood is to be gathered up from any of the park ground areas. It is unlawful to cut, injure, destroy or pick any plant, tree, flower or shrub; or to damage any property operated by the Oakland County Parks and Recreation Commission.
- No clotheslines will be left up overnight. Clotheslines must not be tied to small trees where they may damage the tree.
- All persons will be restricted to the campsites after dark. There is a curfew after dark, and quiet hours will be observed 11pm-7am. All visitors must leave the park by closing time.
- For medical emergencies, call 911 and give your location as: Independence Oaks County Park, Camp Wilderness, 9501 Sashabaw Road, Clarkston.
- Cars are prohibited at the camp site. They must be parked in the designated parking lot, and any gear must be walked into Camp Wilderness (wagon available).
- In case of severe weather, take cover in the restroom building.
