

REPORTABLE DISEASE UPDATE

3rd Quarter 2019 - 2023 · Issued November 15, 2023

The Reportable Disease Update has been developed to communicate infectious disease data and information to our community healthcare partners. This update will be distributed quarterly to identify communicable disease trends and communicate any emerging diseases that may impact our community.

IMPORTANT 3RD QUARTER INFORMATION _____

Lyme Disease: Oakland County continues to see an increase in Lyme disease cases reported as compared to previous years. Q3 of 2023 showed a 255% increase in confirmed, probable, and suspect cases of Lyme disease when compared to Q3 of 2022. Lyme disease is transmitted from the bite of an infected blacklegged tick (also referred to as a deer tick). In Oakland County, post exposure treatment with doxycycline may be considered for individuals that meet the following criteria.

- Tick was removed within the last 72 hours
- · Tick is engorged with blood
- Tick is an Ixodes species (blacklegged/deer)
- · Doxycycline is safe for the patient

Swine Flu at the Oakland County Fair: The Oakland County Health Division (OCHD) was made aware of pigs that tested positive for swine flu at the Oakland County Fair in July. Ninety-six individuals that either worked at or showed animals in the swine barn were identified by fair organizers and OCHD. Contacts were instructed to monitor for symptoms and were referred for testing if they became ill. In total, 4 suspect, 1 probable, and 1 confirmed human case resulted from exposure to the affected swine barn.

Hepatitis A Exposure at Pine Knob Music Theater: In September, the Communicable Disease unit identified a food worker that prepared food in the Ivy Lounge for eight concerts while contagious. OCHD issued a press release notifying the public and provided special vaccination clinics over the weekend to ensure those who were susceptible and exposed were able to receive vaccine within their recommended post-exposure prophylaxis window. There were no known cases from this exposure.

Rabies: There have been twenty-eight confirmed rabies positive animals in Michigan during Q3; three were rabies positive bats in Oakland County.
