- Oakland County Health Division/Oakland County Health & Human Services:
 - Oakland County Health Equity Mini Grant: closed January 29
 - <u>Summer EBT</u>: For the first time, families who are eligible for free and/or reduced school
 meals will also be eligible to receive Summer EBT benefits, which provide benefits
 for families during the summer months when school is not in session. Families need
 to submit applications by January 31. Once on the <u>MDE site</u>, <u>scroll down to student</u>
 eligibility.
- Gleaners Melissa G. shared the extensive nutrition resources available on the <u>Gleaners</u> <u>Community Kitchen webpage</u>. Resources include nutrition education, food safety, cooking demonstration, and downloadable recipes.
- Metro Food Rescue will be involved in food waste pilot project with the city of Southfield.
