Welcome to Addison Oaks Campground

2024 Camping Season: April 26 - Oct. 23

Addison Oaks County Park is a 1,140-acre natural oasis with two lakes where visitors can recreate for the day, camp under the stars or explore the park's rich history. Among its amenities is a 20-mile trail system for hiking and biking, boat/kayak and bike rentals, disc golf, fishing, playgrounds and picnicking.

The campground features 180 campsites, five group camping areas, 2-, 4- or 6-person cabins and 6-person yurts.

All sites have water and 20/30/50 amp electrical service except sites 133-174, which have 20/30 amp.

Cabin and Yurt Amenities

Amenities include:

- 2-person cabin with one queen-sized bed
- 4-person cabins with two twin-sized bunk beds
- 6-person cabins and yurts with two twin-sized bunk beds, one queen-sized bed and air conditioning/heating unit
- Parking for two vehicles

All cabins and yurts are equipped with a small refrigerator, table and chairs, electricity, water nearby, outdoor grill, picnic table, fire pit and microwave.

- Guests must provide their own linens
- Except for service animals, no animals are allowed in (or to remain overnight outside of) cabins or yurts
- Smoking is not permitted inside cabins or yurts
- Gas/portable heaters are not allowed
- No tents are allowed at cabin or yurt sites
- Restrooms located nearby

A \$50 deposit is required at check-in. If no damage is done, the \$50 deposit will be returned at time of departure after inspection has been completed. Credit card preferred for deposit; cash is also accepted.

Tips for Happy Campers

General Reminders

- Quiet hours are 11 p.m.-7 a.m.
- Call the contact station (248-693-2432) with any issues, including noisy neighbors. If the contact station is closed, please call Oakland County Sheriff Dispatch directly (248-858-4950)
- Visitors are welcome from 8 a.m.-10 p.m. An annual or daily permit is required for entry. No visitor entry after 9 p.m.
- Campsites are limited to immediate family or up to four unrelated persons ages 18 years and older. Maximum of two tents or one camper and one tent per site
- When parking, the tongue of trailer hitch must face the road
- Site fee includes two vehicles, only two vehicles allowed per site
- Fire pits are for firewood only; do not put trash, pallets, brush or limbs into the fire pits
- Help keep the park clean by placing all trash into the proper receptacles. Dumpsters are in Areas A and C, across from the shower buildings, and at the dump station. Recycling centers near dumpsters in Areas A and C.
- All gray/wastewater must be disposed of at the designated dump station(s) per the Oakland County Health Division Sanitary Code Section 4.1
- Portable waste tanks may only be connected to a camping unit while in the process of emptying on-board holding tanks campers must be present and in view of portable tanks during the emptying process
- No hose splitters are allowed to be attached to any water spigot or hose per the Oakland County Health Division
- Golf carts are prohibited for use in campgrounds, including the campground roads and pathways
- · Please do not cut or damage trees

Check-in and Check-out Information

- Check-in time for all campsites, cabins and yurts is 3 p.m. (early check-in based on availability-please call ahead)
- Check-in unavailable after 9 p.m. daily.
- Campsite check-out time is 1 p.m.
- Cabin and yurt check-out time is 1 p.m. please notify contact station 30 minutes prior to leaving for inspection

For Your Safety

- Do not feed birds or other wildlife at any time this includes bird feeders attached to or around RVs and trailers
- Cats and dogs are welcome, but must be kept inside or on a 6-foot leash animals may not be left unattended and are not allowed at or in cabins or yurts, and owners or caretakers must pick up all dog droppings
- Hammocks are permitted but may not be permanently attached to trees or campground fixtures
- Clotheslines must be removed at sundown





Cancellation policy for campsites, cabins and yurts:

If notice of cancellation is received seven or more days prior to the beginning of the reservation, all charges will be refunded. If the notice of cancellation is received less than seven days prior to the beginning of the reservation, the reserving person/entity forfeits 50 percent of the fees paid. There will be no refunds for cancellations made after 3 p.m. on the day of the reservation

Reservations

To better accommodate our patrons, beginning with the 2025 camping season, Addison Oaks and Groveland Oaks campgrounds will accept reservations for campsites, cabins, and yurts 180 days (approximately six months) in advance. Groups and facility reservations will continue to be accepted 335 days (approximately 11 months) in advance. The campgrounds will open for the 2025 season on May 1, 2025. For the 2025 camping season, campsite, cabin, and yurt reservations will begin on November 2, 2024

BOAT AND BIKE RENTALS

Located at boathouse on Buhl Lake. Must be 18 years of age or older to rent. Driver's license required. Individuals under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.

Tentative open May 24–Labor Day, weather and staff permitting

Thursday-Sunday: 8 a.m.-8 p.m. (last rental at 7:30 p.m.)

Extended holiday hours posted onsite. Weekends after Labor Day based on staff availability.

PEDAL BOATS: \$5/half hour

KAYAKS: \$5/half hour (1 or 2 seater)

ROW BOATS: \$10/use

MOUNTAIN BIKES: \$5/half hour

Helmet included with rental and must be worn.

SPECIALTY BIKES: \$5/half hour

Helmet recommended and included with rental.

DISC GOLF: Open year round. 18 hole course. Bring your own discs.

FISHING: Shore and dock fishing on Adams and Buhl lakes. Bait available for purchase during camping season.
