What is PACE?

PACE (Property Assessed Clean Energy) is realestate financing available to commercial property owners to reduce energy/water waste.

Why PACE?

Commercial buildings use tremendous amounts of energy. Much of that energy and capital expense become wasted due to energy inefficiencies.

Through PACE, commercial property owners can receive 100% financing for energy efficiency improvements to their buildings. PACE helps property owners in Michigan save on their utility bills and reduce their impacts on the environment.

What is LAGM?

Lean & Green Michigan is the statewide administrator for PACE financing. As of January 2024, LAGM administers PACE in 58 local units of government across Michigan, covering over 75% of the state's population. Cambria Hotel Wayne County

As Michigan's first new construction PACE project, the Cambria Hotel utilized \$19.9 million in PACE financing to build an upscale hotel in the city of Detroit equipped with restaurant, retail, and office space. The energy improvements include HVAC system, building envelope, lighting, and air barriers.

The Laurels of Lake Orion Oakland County

The Laurels of Lake Orion, Oakland County's first senior living facility PACE project, received \$2.1 million in PACE financing to build above code and to a higher efficiency. Improvements to the building envelope, windows, HVAC, plumbing, and lighting will create a sustainable and comfortable environment for future residents.

Boardwalk Traverse City Grand Traverse County

The Boardwalk Traverse City is a five-story mixeduse building. The first floor includes five retail/ commercial units, with residential units on floors two through five. This new construction project utilizes over \$1.7 million in PACE to implement a wide variety of energy efficiency measures to the building envelope, windows, HVAC, lighting, and plumbing.


