

Were you laid off in the past and your employer or Michigan Works! said you were eligible for Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA) benefits? If so, you may still qualify for training support and other services.

The TAA program provides workers with tuition assistance to earn a college degree or certification, as well as other financial assistance to offset the cost of a job search or relocation or, for those who are eligible, extended unemployment insurance benefits.
