DWLS CASES

If you are charged with Driving While License Suspended (DWLS) or a related offense, you may be eligible to participate in Operation Drive. At your pretrial, please discuss this opportunity with your attorney. Your attorney will then work with the prosecutor to see if you may be eligible for the program and what the prosecutor may be willing to offer you based on your driving record. If you do not have an attorney and you are not requesting one, you may still speak with the prosecutor about the program.

WHO WE HELP

Participants in our program generally fall into one of three categories:

- 1) **You have a suspended license** - In this situation, the goal of the program is to help you understand why your license is suspended and to provide guidance to help you clear suspensions and get your license reinstated.
- 2) **You never applied for or obtained a license** - In this situation, the goal of the program is to help you understand the process of applying for a license, such as setting up an appointment and preparing for the written/road tests.
- 3) **You have a revoked license** - In this situation, which will be considered for those who are eligible to apply for license restoration, the goal of the program is to get you in the best possible position to apply for a license and to keep you violation free as you begin the process.

POSSIBLE BENEFITS

Based on your individual case, successful completion of the program could provide you with an opportunity to have the misdemeanor(s) you plead to dismissed on a delayed sentencing date. You may also have an opportunity for your fines and court costs to be reduced on the date of sentencing. Most important, you will get the support you need to clear up issues with your driving record and get on the road as a licensed driver.
