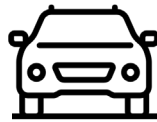
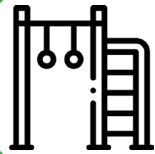

If approved, Oakland County Parks current 0.35 millage would be replaced with a 0.65 millage expiring in 2043, generating approximately \$24 million annually for investment in parks, trails, education and enrichment programs and the preservation of threatened natural areas and green spaces throughout Oakland County. The net .30 increase would equal \$40 or less a year for the average residential taxable value home.
