



Oakland County Opioid Settlement Steering Committee
Meeting #2 | July 16, 2024
Meeting Summary

Data presentation

- Committee members were given a presentation by Oakland County staff about substance use and overdose trends as well as the opioid settlement community listening session results.
- Questions and group discussion
 - Committee members were interested in learning more about the involvement of prescription medications; the changing risk profile for who is using opioids; and why older adults in certain groups have a higher burden of overdose deaths.
 - There were also questions from the committee about most common routes or methods of drug use, which committee members responded that injection was the most common in 2023 followed by oral (locally), oral route rising in 2024.
 - Committee members discussed that there might be opportunities to engage with faith leaders more around needs in their communities as well as resources for helping their members. Faith communities may benefit from an info session/focus group.
