Food Protection Manager Recertification _____

This course is designed for those students who have previously earned a food protection manager certificate and need to re-certify due to an expired certificate. This course is a four-hour review followed by an afternoon exam session. If a certificate is more than ten (10) years old, it is recommended that the full certification course be taken. Please provide a copy of your previous certificate with this registration form.

Requirements for Certification & Recertification Courses _

Attendance: Attendance is required for the duration of the class to sit for the exam.

Refunds: Once enrolled in a class, there will be no refunds. Students may be able to transfer to another open class if arrangements are made at least 48 hours prior to the start of the class they are enrolled in.
