- #Measles symptoms can take 21 days to show after potential exposure. Call your doctor if you believe you were exposed. <http://bit.ly/2YeciIv>
- Unvaccinated individuals need to get vaccinated within 72 hours of measles exposure. Get vaccinated. <http://bit.ly/2XY8Y4f>
- Immune-globulin treatment is effective within 6 days of measles exposure for high-risk individuals (those with a compromised immune system, unvaccinated or pregnant).
- Contracting measles is serious. Complications can include pneumonia, brain swelling, and preterm birth. <http://bit.ly/2Osns7R>
- Experiencing #measles symptoms? Call ahead before visiting your doctor or emergency room.
- Experiencing measles symptoms? Call your doctor, share your symptoms and travel history. Follow your doctor's guidance.
- Measles are highly contagious, and are spread through the air and person-to-person contact. Don't let visitors into your home if you are sick!
