
CONSOLIDATION OF SOBRIETY COURT CASES

The 3rd division of the 52nd District Court will consolidate any subsequent cases where the defendant is already an active participant in Sobriety Court with either Judge Nicholson or Judge Carniak in the following manner:

If the defendant is assigned to either Judge Nicholson or Judge Carniak's Sobriety Court Program and the defendant receives another misdemeanor case assigned to either Judge Nicholson or Judge Carniak, the latter case will be assigned to the judge with the active Sobriety Court case.

This order only applies to cases assigned to Judge Nicholson and/or Judge Carniak. It does not apply to any cases assigned to Judge Asadoorian.
