ORDER AUTHORIZING OAKLAND COUNTY REIMBURSEMENT DIVISION  
ADMINISTRATIVE ABILITY TO REDUCE/AMEND FINANCIAL ORDER

IT APPEARING TO THE COURT that pursuant to Michigan Court Rule 8.112(B) that a trial court may issue administrative orders governing internal court management,

IT FURTHER APPEARING that in order to assure that Oakland County Probate Court and the County Reimbursement Division manage its administrative responsibilities efficiently, and

IT APPEARING that to do so, and upon the request of the Oakland County Reimbursement Division, certain actions can be effected without Court intervention,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Manager, Oakland County


Reimbursement Division, is authorized to reduce Financial Orders of this Court and/or to approve placing on inactive status, efforts to collect certain accounts when indebtedness is less than \$2,500 when said Manager, upon review of financial ability or efforts toward collection deem this to be a proper action.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Manager is also authorized to reactivate collection efforts in the event that additional information becomes available that would assist in collection on cases earlier made inactive, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order has immediate effect.
