ORDER ESTABLISHING PAYMENT POLICY, AND METHODS
FOR APPOINTED ATTORNEYS AND GUARDIANS AD LITEM

IT APPEARING TO THE COURT that pursuant to Michigan Court Rule 8.112(B) that a trial court may issue administrative orders governing internal court management,

IT FURTHER APPEARING that a uniform, equitable payment process for appointed attorneys and guardians ad litem is in the best interests of the court, Oakland County, the parties represented, and the appointed individuals themselves,

IT FURTHER APPEARING that prudent fiscal management is furthered by distinguishing and thus limiting those situations where exceptions to standard practices will be permitted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that appointed attorneys and guardians ad litem will be compensated on the basis of flat fee schedules, which schedules may be amended from time to time by


further order of the court.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all requests for fees in excess or beyond the scope of these schedules must be accompanied by an itemized explanation of reasons for the request, thereafter to be submitted to the assigned Judge for the judge's consideration.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no fee payment shall issue for nonconforming requests.


