Unbox the fun with our programs, specially designed to meet Next Generation Science Standards. Our staff will drop off a box of sanitized lesson supplies to your school. Then, tune in for 45-60 minutes of live instruction via Zoom with a naturalist from Oakland County Parks and Recreation's Nature Education Team. After the lesson is over, an Oakland County staff member will collect the reusable items in the kit.

Take and Learn Virtual Field Trips

Grade Level	Topic	Standards	Description
Preschool	Animal Track Detectives	N/A	Become nature detectives and learn about local wildlife through the evidence (tracks, feathers, fur) they leave behind. Students can make their own stories with the Animal Track Craft Stamp Kit on a poster or a cloth item that you provide (T-shirt, pillowcase, tote bag, etc.).
Kindergarten	Reducing Our Impact	K-ESS2-2, K-ESS3-1, K2-ETS1-1	Learn about the effect animals have on their habitats. Brainstorm ways (both good and bad) that humans change their environment and make a craft from upcycled materials.
1 st Grade	Nature Invented it First	1-LS1-1	Engineers solve problems by looking to nature for help. Learn how nature has inspired many inventions that helped to solve human problems.
2 nd Grade	Stuck on You	2-LS2-2	Learn about seed dispersal and pollination when we explore how animal behavior helps to create new plants. Students will participate in a hands-on experiment to illustrate how seeds are dispersed from one place to another with a little help from animals.
3 rd -5 th Grades	Wild About Wolves	3-LS2-1, 3-LS4-3, 4-LS1-1, 4-LS1-2, 4-LS4-4, 5-LS2-1, 5PS3.D.4	Did you know wolves live in Michigan? Become a wolf and learn how to be a member of a pack, "speak" wolf and catch prey. This is a "howling" good lesson!
4 th & 5 th Grades	Pellets Aren't Puke	4-LS1-1, 4-LS1-2, 4.G.A.-3, 5-PS3-1, 5-LS2-1	Learn how owls are connected to other animals (and even plants!) in the food web by measuring and dissecting an owl pellet.
